## Bed and Breakfast at St Catherine's College

St Catherine's is conveniently located in a peaceful setting within the City of Oxford. During vacations, where we have availability, we often offer private B&B accommodation set within our beautiful grounds.







Guests are accommodated in our light and airy student study bedrooms (home to our students during term times) in buildings of modern architectural interest.

**Free Wi-Fi access** is now available to all B&B guests across the College via the Sky-powered service 'The Cloud' (please note that standard mobile telephone reception may be limited depending upon exact location and mobile provider). Guests over the age of 18 are also very welcome to utilise our on-site gym, access to which can be granted via the Lodge.

Please note that **bookings and extensions to bookings** <u>can only be made online</u> - fees for accommodation <u>cannot</u> be paid directly at the College. There may be cut-off deadlines for online booking facilities and so it is always best to book/amend bookings at least 48 hours before the room is needed.

## Important information for bed and breakfast guests:

- Check-in to bedrooms is any time after 14:00 hrs on the day of arrival and happens at our Porter's Lodge (open 24/7 and so late check-ins are not a problem);
- All bedrooms and internal areas of the College are non-smoking;
- **Breakfast** (served between 8:00 and 9:00 hrs) is usually a self-service continental or 'full English' buffet-style meal taken in the main Dining Hall;
- Bedrooms come complete with linen, towels, toiletries and tea and coffee-making facilities;
- Your main point of contact during your visit and in case of emergency is our Porters Lodge (in person or via 01865 271700);
- Check-Out is by 10:00hrs promptly on the day of departure (please return keys to the Lodge);
- There is usually a small luggage storage area available at the lodge for guests to use;
- We regret that parking facilities are <u>NOT</u> available to B&B guests

## Additional useful information:

- \* Bedrooms are located throughout the College on different floors and are basically but comfortably furnished (NB: there are no televisions/radios in the bedrooms and no lift access to upper floors). All ensuite study bedrooms have their own private shower and toilet as well as tea and coffee making facilities, towels, linen and toiletries.
- If you have an access requirement to consider, please contact us before booking and we will always try to assist where possible. A wheelchair-adapted room may be available on request (subject to availability) please contact us **before** booking to enquire.

Our beautiful gardens (also part of Arne Jacobsen's original design) are noted as being 'of interest' by English Heritage and are open to all guests.

During vacations, the College Bar and Resident's Lounge (located in the JCR) may also be available for bed and breakfast guests to use from 18:00hrs onwards (note – this is usually available but depends upon any conference activity potentially booked into those locations).

There are many restaurants, bars and cafés in the nearby City centre. It may also be possible to book dinner in the College Dining Hall (subject to availability) - please contact us to enquire before booking your bedroom.

If you specifically wish to stay in a 'Jacobsen bedroom' (and original 1960s room located in the older area of College), please note this on your booking or contact us separately to check availability. NB: these rooms are offered subject to availability as there are a limited number.

For groups of guests interested in the architecture and design of the College, specialist tours or accommodation packages with tailored 'extras' may available during your stay. Please enquire in advance if this may be of interest to you.

Please note that parking is not available at the College for bed and breakfast guests
